I am a volunteer firefighter. You see me in my personally owned vehicle that I have outfitted with emergency lights. I may be headed to do CPR on



someone's unresponsive loved one, often as the family watches and prays for their loved one's survival. What you don't see is me trying to catch a family member in an attempt to keep them from completely collapsing after being told their loved one didn't make it.

You may not know that I'm headed to try to save a home that a family grew up in, to attempt to save their belongings and leave them with more than what they have on their backs. I may gear up and go inside a burning building, risking my life in an attempt to locate the unaccounted for family member or pet of people I've never met before. I try to comfort the person who just lost everything they own to a fire.

I may have to crawl inside a mangled car that was hit by a drunk driver, holding the hand of a bloody, frightened teenager and trying to calm them, telling them it'll be ok, as my fellow firefighters cut the wrecked and twisted steel away to free this scared kid from the car.

I may have to be pulled away at a moment's notice from dining with my family or leave a holiday dinner because someone needs help.

I make sacrifices to be there for others. I don't do all these things because it's fun. I am not a volunteer firefighter because I think it's neat to "play" with fire trucks. I do all this because I love my community and want to keep it safe. I do this because I AM a volunteer firefighter!
