B.F. Goodrich Marker

John Hamels, Ripley Town Historian, received an offer to place an historical marker commemorating Ripley as the birthplace of B.F. Goodrich.

Since the home where Goodrich lived is no longer in exist-
 ence, the marker will be placed on Ripley Public Library prop-
 erty, fittingly at the corner of Main and Goodrich Streets.

Goodrich was born in Ripley on November 4, 1841 and went
 on to become an industrialist in the rubber industry and
 founded B.F. Goodrich Company in Akron, Ohio.

Ripley Food Pantry

The Ripley Food Pantry, under the direction of Phil Chimera,
 operates two days a week, providing emergency and supple-
 mental food needs for the residents of Ripley. A person is eli-
 gible for food assistance if they verbally attest to falling into
 the income guidelines or if they or someone in their house-
 hold participates in SNAP, WIC, TANF, unemployment, SSI, or
 Free/Reduced lunch program.

You must have a photo ID, Social Security card, medical card,
 driver’s license, voter registration or Proof of Residency or a
 referral from a Pastor or Food Pantry Worker in order to re-
 ceive assistance.

The Food Pantry is open Tuesdays from 2:00-4:00 p.m. and
 Saturdays from 10:00-11:50a.m. Volunteers are needed!
