## **Hygiene Kits** Items:

One comb-Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth One toenail or fingernail clipper

No emery boards or metal nail files

Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger) No Ivory or Jergens soap-Do not remove from packaging

One adult toothbrush-Do not remove from packaging (personal advertising not acceptable)

10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches)-Common household bandages acceptable

One one-gallon size resealable bag
