What is a Safe Place Location, you might ask. A Safe Place works with the Safe House out of Jamestown and is part of Chautauqua Opportunities, Inc. This is a program for runaway or homeless youth under the age of 18. If this youth needs help, all they do is enter the facility displaying the yellow sign that reads SAFE PLACE. They let someone in charge know they need help.






Community Table

FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

A motion was made at our last Library Board meeting by John Hamels, to change the title of the current Head Clerk to Assistant Director and to establish line items for two aids whose job titles will be the same as a library clerk. The Board unanimously passed this motion.

The library also needs to start a survey to be completed by patrons. The survey will run for several months and give the library a feel of what the townspeople would like to see at their library and detail what their money is already giving to them. Look for it in the coming months.
